






# How to sort and dispose of garbage

Garbage types	Main rules for separating garbage	
	【When throwing out garbage, please follow these points】	
<b>Mondays and Thursdays</b> <b>Tuesdays and Fridays</b> <b>Burnable garbage</b>	Burnable garbage should be properly placed in City designated trash bags. Cut tree branches into pieces 50cm long and 10cm thick or less. Bundle them together and tie them with string. Throw out 2-3 bundles at a time. Use a transparent or translucent bag Large amounts of garbage cannot be thrown out at the garbage station. Throw it out over several garbage days or take it directly to the Clean Center. (Fee is charged)	
<b>Tuesdays</b> <b>Mondays</b> <b>Plastic bottles</b> 	【Types included】 Items with PET logo Juices, soy sauce, sake, seasoning for noodles, etc.	【Not included】 Detergent, shampoo containers, labels, bottle caps, etc. Sauce or cooking oil bottles ⇒ <b>burnable garbage</b>
<b>Every Wednesday</b> <b>Every Wednesday</b> 	【Types included】 Only clean items with a plastic logo can be thrown out Plastic packaging, plastic containers, styrofoam, colored trays *There are special collection boxes for white trays located in community centers and supermarkets.	【Not included】 Oily or dirty items ⇒ <b>burnable garbage</b> Pumps for shampoo containers, etc. ⇒ <b>Non-burnable garbage</b>
<b>1st and 3rd Wednesdays</b> <b>2nd and 4th Wednesdays</b> <b>Non-burnable garbage</b>	【Types included】 Be sure to cut off the electrical cords of small household appliances that are not major appliances Put small items such as razors, needles, and broken glass in empty candy cans Sizes up to 50cm long x 30cm high x 30 cm wide	【Not included】 Furniture (drawers, shelves, etc.), bicycles, and bedding such as futons that do not fit in designated bags are oversized garbage (fees apply).
<b>2nd and 4th Wednesdays</b> <b>1st and 3rd Wednesdays</b> <b>Newspapers, books, magazines, cardboard boxes</b>	【Types included】 Limited to items that are tied with string and in good condition. Do not put in plastic bags or paper bags.	【Not included】 If dirty, it's burnable garbage
<b>Milk cartons</b> 	【Types included】 Only cartons with a white inside. Wash the inside, cut open until flat, and let it dry.	【Not included】 If the inside has an aluminum coating or is brown, it's burnable garbage
<b>Other paper containers and packaging, miscellaneous waste paper</b>	【Types included】 Items with the paper logo, paper bags, wrapping paper, postcards, envelopes, shredded paper, toilet paper cardboard tubes	【Not included】 Items that are waterproofed, coated with aluminum, etc., dirty, or smelly are burnable garbage
<b>Clothes · Cloth</b>	【Types included】 Clothes in good condition, absorbent cloth Jackets, pants, skirts, scarves, towels, etc.	【Not included】 Down jackets, coats, leather jackets, underwear, socks, dust cloths, non-absorbent items (curtains, lace fabrics) are burnable garbage
<b>3rd Thursdays</b> <b>3rd Fridays</b> <b>Dangerous garbage</b>	【Types included】 Explosive or flammable items Cigarette lighters, aerosol cans, batteries (batteries, rechargeable batteries, button batteries), mobile phone batteries, etc. Harmful objects Fluorescent lamps containing mercury, fluorescent tubes, thermometers, etc.	【Not included】 LED and incandescent light bulbs are non-burnable garbage.
<b>Fridays other than the 3rd</b> <b>Cans</b> <b>Thursdays other than the 3rd</b> 	【Types included】	【Not included】
<b>3rd Fridays</b> <b>Bottles</b> <b>3rd Thursdays</b>	Beverage bottles and cans, tin cans, and jam and sauce jars should be thoroughly washed before disposal.	Oily bottles, bottle caps that cannot be washed are non-burnable garbage..

① Make an appointment for pickup Call for appointment: 0289-64-3362 Office hours: Mondays - Fridays (8:30-5:00) Office closed 12:00-1:00PM ② Buy a sticker Buy the required number of stickers Where to buy stickers: Citizens' Division, Community Centers, Clean Center *Stickers cannot be returned ③ Put out the trash by 8:30AM on collection day Put a sticker on the item you want to dispose of and put it in the designated place (in front of your house, etc.)	Oversized/bulky trash	Furniture, bedding, bicycles, gas/kerosene heaters, etc.	200 yen per item
	Items difficult to dispose of	Exercise equipment, spring mattresses, sofas, electric bicycles, etc.	2,000 yen per item
	Specific electric household appliances	Air conditioners, TVs, refrigerators, washing machines (Recycling fee will vary by manufacturer and/or item.)	2,000 yen per item + recycling fee per item
	Dead animals	Dogs, cats, etc.	1,400 yen per animal body *Dead animals on the street will be picked up for free if the owner is unknown.
